PSED (Personal, Social & Emotional Development):

Art focus - Mrs Murray is going to do the art focus this week. She will purchase some fish from the fishmongers so the children can look closely at the mouth, gills and scales. Afterwards, they will paint it and make a print of it; a little bit smelly but a wonderful way of seeing a fish close up!

Self-help skill - Practising putting shoes back on after taking them off: we are very quick at taking them off but not so fast at putting them back on!

Snack - Raisins, ricecakes, satsumas, peppers, cucumbers, apples and broccoli.
