Math: We will continue with the composition of numbers and recognition of higher numbers. We will also continue building on the children's knowledge of combining two groups.

Understanding the world: Our science experiment will be magic milk, we will run various experiments throughout the term, encouraging the children to predict outcomes and ask appropriate questions.

Expressive arts and design: Our Artist of the month will be Jackson Pollock and we will be doing a project based on his 'action' paintings with a messy garden session!

Show and tell: Children can bring in any science related books or come dressed up as a scientist on Wednesday. Or bring in a picture/drawing about science such as an experiment done at home or a visit to the Science Museum.
